A New Clean Water and Wastewater Fund for Provinces, Territories and Provinces

#Budget2016 will invest \$2 billion over four years, starting in 2016–17, for immediate improvements to water distribution and treatment infrastructure.

- We will support for urgent provincial, territorial and municipal water and wastewater priorities.
- Funding will be delivered to communities this year.
- To get projects moving quickly, we will fund up to 50 per cent of eligible costs for projects.
- This investment will improve the safety and quality of water for Canadian families, while supporting job creation and a clean growth economy.

Water Supply and Wastewater Treatment for First Nations

All Canadians deserve access to clean water.

- We will improve the infrastructure of water supply and wastewater treatment and waste management on reserve on First Nations reserves across Canada.
- We will invest \$2.24 billion over 5 years for access to clean and safe water within First Nations communities.
- This will ultimately put an end to the use of boil water advisories on reserves.

The Liberal Government will make it easier and more financially rewarding for Canadian businesses to invest in creating clean jobs. #Budget2016 will boost our economic growth by investing in clean technology.

We are investing \$5 billion in water supply, wastewater treatment and green infrastructure across Canada.
