# FEDERAL INVESTMENTS IN MBQ, DESERONTO, AND TYENDINAGA TOWNSHIP

## Small Communities Fund

- \$2,448,333 to renew and upgrade the Deseronto Water Treatment Plant, also serving the MBQ.

- \$66,171 to Deseronto for sewage pumping station electrical upgrades.

- \$49,500 to MBQ for “Celebrating 150 Years of Struggle, Strife, and Perseverance Together.”

## Canada 150—Infrastructure

- \$18,035 to MBQ toward flooring for the Tyendinaga Fitness Centre.
